

## MODERN URBAN APARTMENT

Natalia Miyar was commissioned to create a modern urban apartment, made bespoke with a combination of textures, colour and pattern. The layout of the property has been redesigned to join two separate apartments in the 19th-century building in Belgravia. The addition of a roof extension with an open-plan layout was key to restructuring the interior architecture of the property. Natalia encouraged her client to play with colour, texture and pattern to introduce warmth to the crisp, modern lines of the contemporary apartment. The clean architectural lines of the home have been softened with mink-toned flooring, grey stone, and accent hues of blue, ochre and rust, to create a palette that is masculine yet warm. Character is intensified by materials of sculpted bronze, richly veined marble, and copper that will gain patina over time.
